Public Meeting Information & Public Participation Policy

INTRODUCTION

Under the Kansas Open Meetings Act (KOMA), the public has the right to observe the meetings of the Towanda City Council unless the City Council has recessed into a lawfully conducted executive session. The KOMA does not require public comment; the opportunity is provided at the City Council's discretion, except as required by State law or City ordinance in specific circumstances. This policy outlines the various circumstances under which the City Council meets and elaborates on the City Council's Rules of Procedure by addressing the rules regarding the time, place, and manner of public participation in the City Council meetings from the standpoint of the participating member of the public. This policy is intended to strike a lawful balance between First Amendment protections and the substantial public interests of (1) assuring that meetings of the City Council can occur in an efficient, orderly, and safe manner and (2) promoting productive public discourse regarding the governance and administration of the City while maintaining decorum in an environment free from interference, distraction, or intimidation, whether real or perceived, by any person present in the meeting room toward the Council or members of the public.

SUBMISSION OF WRITTEN INFORMATION

Written information may be submitted to the City Clerk before noon on Thursday prior to a City Council meeting for distribution to Council and key staff members or may be presented during the meeting upon recognition by the Mayor as a speaker in the manner described below. Ten (10) copies should be provided to ensure that all applicable parties are able to receive and review the information provided.

FORMS OF COMMUNICATION OR EXPRESSION NOT ALLOWED IN THE MEETING ROOM

To assure fulfillment of the substantial public interests outlined above, no member of the public attending the City Commission meeting shall in the meeting room engage in the following forms of communication or expression found by the City Council to be in conflict with the substantial public interests outlined above and, therefore, not allowed in the meeting room (the "disallowed conduct"):

Before, during, or after the meeting:

(1) Possessing, placing, or displaying a sign, placard, flag, or banner, regardless of its size, the material of which it is made, or its written, graphic, or symbolic content;

During the meeting:

(2) Audibly speaking, or making any sound or noise other than while speaking as a speaker recognized by the mayor;

(3) Applauding, whistling, cheering, clapping, or otherwise expressing agreement with a speaker recognized by the mayor;

(4) Booing, jeering, taunting, ridiculing, mocking or otherwise expressing disagreement with a speaker recognized by the mayor;

(5) Inaudibly mouthing or gesturing messages deemed to be distracting to other persons in the meeting room;

(6) Making available or distributing written materials to those in attendance.

Persons attending a City Commission meeting must turn off or set on vibrate all cellular telephones. Any person exhibiting any form of the disallowed conduct will first be warned by the Mayor to cease. If the person continues the disallowed conduct, the Mayor may ask the person to leave the meeting room. If the person does not promptly leave the meeting room, the Mayor may direct that the person be escorted from the meeting room.

AGENDA ITEMS

CONSENT AGENDA

The Consent Agenda assembles routine action items for collective approval in the interest of efficiency of the meeting. Any item may be removed from the Consent Agenda for separate consideration either (a) at the request of a Council Member or City staff, or (b) by a majority vote of the City Council upon request by a Towanda resident directed to City staff or to a Council Member prior to the start of the meeting without discussion.

PRESENTATIONS AND GUEST SPEAKERS

Presentations and Guest Speakers Time is an opportunity for organizations or citizens to make special presentations before the City Council. Such are scheduled in advance of the meeting by calling the City Clerk Sarah Gooding at (316) 536-2243 by 5:00 pm the Thursday preceding the meeting. Presentations are limited to ten minutes. Any presentation is for information purposes only; no action will be taken.

PUBLIC HEARINGS AND REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS

Following the introduction of any public hearing or regular agenda item, consideration of the item will ordinarily begin with a staff report, followed by Council Member questions of staff. If the matter involves an applicant, the applicant or the applicant's representative will be given the opportunity to address the City Council.

In the case of a public hearing, the public hearing shall be conducted in the manner required by State law or Towanda ordinance, and any person entitled to address the City Council shall be provided that opportunity, regardless of his or her viewpoint on the matter, subject to the allowed time period.

In the case of a regular agenda item, subject to the discretion of the City Council, any interested persons wishing to address the City Council regarding the subject of the agenda item, regardless of his or her viewpoint on the matter, may be given the opportunity to do so, subject to the allowed time period.

In the case of either a public hearing or regular agenda item, those allowed to address the City Council may do so by, in turn, approaching the podium to be recognized by the mayor.

- Upon recognition by the Mayor, the speaker must indicate his or her name and city of residence and may address the subject of the agenda item for no longer than the allowed time period which is typically three (3) minutes but may be altered and announced by the Mayor

based upon the number of persons expected to speak during the public hearing or regular agenda item.

- While addressing the City Council, the speaker may request permission from the Mayor to distribute any written information regarding the subject of the agenda item to City Council Members, the City Administrator/City Clerk.
- The speaker should avoid repeating what has already been said and should feel free to simply state whether he or she is or is not in support of the matter being discussed.
- A speaker should not expect to engage in two-way dialogue with the City Council.
- A speaker should provide his or her comments for Council consideration at their discretion.

PUBLIC COMMENT TIME

Public Comment Time provides an opportunity for Towanda citizens to address the City Council on a topic that is not on the meeting agenda.

After the Mayor announces the Public Comment Time:

- Any citizen wishing to address the City Council should, in turn, approach the podium to be recognized by the Mayor.
- There are no residency requirements.
- Upon recognition by the Mayor, the speaker must indicate his or her name and city of residence and may address the City Council for no longer than the allowed time period which is typically three (3) minutes but may be altered and announced by the Mayor based upon the number of persons expected to speak during the Public Comment Time.
- While addressing the City Council, the speaker may request permission from the Mayor to distribute any written information to Council Members, the City Manager, and the City Clerk.
- The City Council is not expected to take immediate action in response to the presentation.
- At the discretion of the City Council, subjects introduced under Public Comment Time may be referred to City staff for follow-up or may become an agenda item for a future meeting.
- A speaker should not expect to engage in two-way dialogue with the City Council.
- A speaker should provide his or her comments for Council consideration at their discretion.
 - Comments or questions will be directed **only** to the City Council.
- Debate or arguments between parties in the audience is not allowed.
- Comments on personnel matters and matters pending in court are not permitted.

In order for the Council to have an opportunity to review comments in advance of the meeting, please email your comments or questions to administrator@cityoftowanda.com by 5:00 p.m. the Tuesday prior to the Wednesday meetings.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

The Kansas Open Meetings Act allows the City Council to recess into an executive session based upon certain justifications outlined in the act. The City Council may recess into executive session based upon a motion that includes (1) a statement describing the subjects to be discussed during the executive session, (2) the statutory justification for the executive session, and (3) the time and place at which the open meeting shall resume. Executive sessions are closed to the public, however, once the executive session has concluded, members of the public may return to the meeting room.

OTHER ITEMS

STUDY/WORKSHOP SESSION

The City Council may meet in study session on topics determined by the City Administrator or the City Council on a specific date and time. As the name suggests, the study/workshop session is intended to provide a less formal opportunity for the City Council to study, discuss, and provide direction to City staff regarding the subject under study. Study sessions are open to the public; however, the extent of public participation is subject to the discretion of the City Council based upon available time during the study session and the need for public input in order to accomplish the objectives of the City Council in studying the subject of the study session.

SPECIAL LIMITED PUBLIC FORUM

A special limited public forum may be called by the City Council for the purposes of

- (a) conducting public discussion and
- (b) seeking public comment and/or the submission of written information regarding a particular subject matter.

A special limited public forum may be convened in the City Council's regular meeting room or at an alternative, publicly accessible site suitable for the anticipated number of participants in the forum.

At the appointed time on the agenda, any persons wishing to address the City Council regarding the subject of the special limited public forum, regardless of their viewpoint on the matter, may do so by, in turn, approaching the podium or microphone to be recognized by the Mayor.

- Upon recognition by the Mayor, the speaker must indicate his or her name and city of residence and may address the subject of the special limited public forum for no longer than the allowed time period determined and announced by the mayor based upon the number of persons expected to speak during the forum.
- While addressing the City Council, the speaker may request permission from the Mayor to distribute any written information regarding the subject of the special limited public forum to the City Council, the City Administrator, and the City Clerk.

Angel Ramsey made a motion to approve the consent agenda, seconded by Kit Williams. Motion carried 5-0.

5. Public Comment Time

6. Presentations and Guest Speakers

A. 2025 Audit Presentation

John Regier, with Loyd Group, presented the City's 2025 Audit, which provides external insight into the City's management process and includes recommendations to address any significant deficiencies identified.

The auditors concluded that the City's financial statements fairly present its financial position and operating results. Additionally, the following recommendations were made for improved management practices.

- Confirm organizational knowledge and understanding for financial statement reporting
- Enhanced policies and procedures, including employee handbook, written policies and procedures for accounting and security procedures, anti-fraud policies, procedures for backup, purchasing, dollar thresholds for bidding, employee data access, debt policies and journal entry policies and procedures.
- Segregation of duties for transaction processing.
- Bank reconciliation review procedures and process for dealing with outstanding checks
- Procedures for journal entry review
- Credit card policy creation
- Utility billing reconciliation procedures
- Develop policies to deal with issues found in expense testing
- Processes for documenting payroll adjustments
- Tightening up financial transition controls for the Towanda Public Library
- Ensure that the City does not have negative cash balances in any funds, which has occurred each of the past two years in the water fund.
- Build reserve balances so that all funds have at least a 3-6 month cash carryover balance

Regier also provided an overview of the audit report.

Drew Shaults asked if auditors saw anything specifically concerning in their review, and John said the cash balance is the most concerning and should be considered as the City wraps up its budget for 2027. Beyond that, segregation of duties, internal controls, and other policy updates should top the list.

Angel Ramsey asked about priorities and timeframe for making changes. John said it is difficult to focus on everything, but again emphasized the internal controls and items governed by statute, such as cash-basis violations and outstanding checks.

Drew Shauls made a motion to accept and file the audit report, seconded by Drew Shauls. Motion carried 5-0.

7. Old Business

A. SRF Water Loan Preliminary Award

Towanda submitted a pre-application for loan funding from the Kansas Water Office's Kansas State Revolving Fund (SRF) program for water system updates, and incorporated a commitment to replace lead service lines to enhance overall likelihood of receiving the assistance. Towanda was not selected for overall system funding, but was pre-awarded a \$2,225,000 loan for costs related to inventorying or replacing lead service lines. This loan has an interest rate at 60% of market rate and is 50% forgivable.

There are opportunities to use this loan in combination with future applications for system grant funding, as well as potential benefits related to public health and compliance, efficiencies, and some water loss mitigation efforts.

Kit Williams said the City should pursue this and this provides a helpful opportunity for members of the community.

Council members identified several questions that JEO's Project Manager Sasha Hahn said she would research and bring back to the public hearing.

- Anticipated monthly cost for the City
- Whether the proposed interest rate is fixed or variable
- Loan term length once repayment begins and how soon repayment begins

Sasha Hahn also said between now and November 2027, Towanda needs to work on tightening up its baseline inventory of lead service lines, and this funding opportunity can assist with the costs of validating inventories and developing a replacement plan.

Drew Shauls made a motion to direct the City Administrator to proceed with submitting a loan application to the Kansas Water Office Public Water Supply Loan Fund (KPWSLF) in the amount of \$2,425,000, and schedule a Special Meeting on September 30, 2026 for purposes of holding a project hearing. The motion was seconded by Angel Ramsey and carried 5-0.

B. 309 Main Street Updates & Continuation of Tabled Dilapidation Hearing

In July Council conducted a dilapidated structure hearing and opted to continue the hearing to August. City Administrator Sarah Gooding said staff continue to work through processes for both demolition and pursuit of the grant, and advised that Council continue the hearing to September 9.

Chris Hunt questioned the recommendation to table the hearing again. Gooding advised staff have been in conversation with Mr. Jones and his team regarding the grant, and at this point the city does not have a complete grant application.

Chris said he does not believe staff has time to continue and table this issue. Angel Ramsey said she agrees. Drew Shaults said Mr. Jones is present and advised that his team have time to say his piece.

Contractor Roberto Baeza said he is waiting on the City to tell them he and building owner Perry Jones what day the information is needed. He said staff told him they should wait until September 9 to submit information.

Gooding said staff and Mr. Jones have been discussing financial security tools for Phase I, total costs and funding stack for Phase II construction, and projections for the five-year project compliance period, including a proforma that shows that the project is likely to succeed and monetize. She said staff do not have the proforma or Phase II information. Once it became apparent that information would not be available for the August meeting, staff recommended planning toward a September 9 presentation.

Perry Jones said he keeps asking if any more information is needed, and he believes he has provided everything needed and is waiting on the City for the balance of information, including approval of the application. Gooding said the City has continued to ask for remedy of application deficiencies, but they have not yet been remedied.

At the request of Council, Gooding clarified that staff recommendation is to continue the discussion to September 9. City Attorney Rob Lane noted that part of the recommendation for the continuation is that nothing is lost.

Rob Lane also provided an update on the City's recommendation that the City grant liability be secured by funds in escrow, in case the project fails and the City becomes responsible for repayment of federal grant funds. He said the City is not interested in proceeding as application for grant without an escrow account as a security, and the property owner has advised in no uncertain terms that they aren't interested in an escrow agreement.

Property Owner Perry Jones spoke and said he guarantees he will not hold the City responsible. He said he doesn't want to tie up his funds in escrow and believes there are other ways of securing the project without this step. He asked if a lien on the property could be an option?

Chris Hunt said many other past guarantees have been made by Mr. Jones that Rob Lane said the Council was clear that they wanted funds in escrow. Perry was clear that he was not willing to put funds in escrow. Rob clarified that the escrow provision is a deal breaker for the City.

Chris Hunt made a motion to stop the application with SCKEDD on behalf of City staff, seconded by Kit Willaims. The motion carried 5-0.

8. New Business

A. Standard Traffic Ordinance Updates

Annually, the City is required to adopt the latest version of the Standard Traffic ordinance for Kansas Cities for the purpose of regulating traffic within the city limits of Towanda.

Jennifer Watkins made a motion to Adopt Ordinance No. 735 adopting the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, 53rd Edition, seconded by Drew Shaults.

B. Uniform Public Offense Code Updates

Annually the City is required to adopt the latest version of the Public Offense Code for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the city limits of Towanda.

Jennifer Watkins made a motion to Adopt Ordinance No. 736 adopting the Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities 42nd Edition, seconded by Drew Shaults. Motion carried 5-0.

C. Ordinance regarding Cereal Malt Beverage Sales

Current City Code controlling Business Regulations for the sale of Cereal Malt Beverages needs to be updated to reflect current State Statutes.

Jennifer Watkins made a motion to Adopt Ordinance No. 737 amending Towanda City Code Chapter 3 Beverages Article 2: Section 3-213(k) to conform with KSA 41-2704, seconded by Kit Williams. Motion carried 5-0.

D. Job Descriptions for Hiring

Job descriptions were presented to Council for approval for two vacant positions on staff. The updated descriptions focus heavily on the qualifications and key abilities that prepare someone to succeed in these roles, with the anticipation that knowledge and skills can be developed through training and experience.

Chris Hunt made a motion to approve the updated job descriptions for Deputy City Clerk/Utility Clerk and General Maintenance Worker I – PT, seconded by Jen Watkins. Motion carried 5-0.

E. Council Priorities

City Administrator Sarah Gooding began presenting a refined priority list for Council, when a request was made to table the discussion until all Council members could be present for it in person.

Jennifer Watkins made a motion to table the discussion, seconded by Kit Williams. Motion passed 5-0.

F. Contract for Support

City Administrator Sarah Gooding presented a proposed contract with Guv Guy Consulting for strategic assistance. She said we are at a place where community goals are pushing past systems that are in place, and the community is asking for serious investment. In the past 12 months, the community has approved 2.5% in sales tax for its water, street and public safety goals. The organization must adapt to achieve those goals.

The proposed contract provides a very broad scope to address emerging needs, ranging from technical financial assistance to strategic initiatives such as police department development.

Gooding said the contract cost is not realistic as proposed, but she would like to see some support in the next couple of months and then drop assistance down to on-call or targeted toward Council priorities.

Mayor Mike Hayes noted that if the City adopts the contract as proposed there would also be an obligation to budget for the potential liability.

Drew Shaults said he isn't sure this is what is best for the City at this time as the Administrator prepares to hire two new employees. He expressed concerns about split focus between onboarding new hires and consultation.

Chris Hunt made a motion to table to September 9, Second by Jennifer Watkins. The motion carried 5-0.

9. Other Business & Announcements

10. Executive Session

A. Discussions concerning security matters

Jennifer Watkins made a motion that the Council recess into executive session for 20 minutes for discussions concerning security matters pursuant to the justification listed in K.S. A. 75-4319(b)12. Included in this session will be the Mayor, Council, City Attorney, and City Administrator. The open meeting will resume in the Towanda City Council Room at 9:19 p.m. The motion was seconded by Kit Williams and carried 5-0.

At 9:19 p.m. Jennifer Watkins made a motion to come out of executive session, seconded by Drew Shaults. Motion carried 5-0.

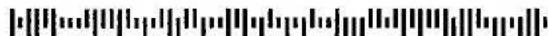

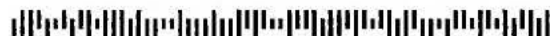

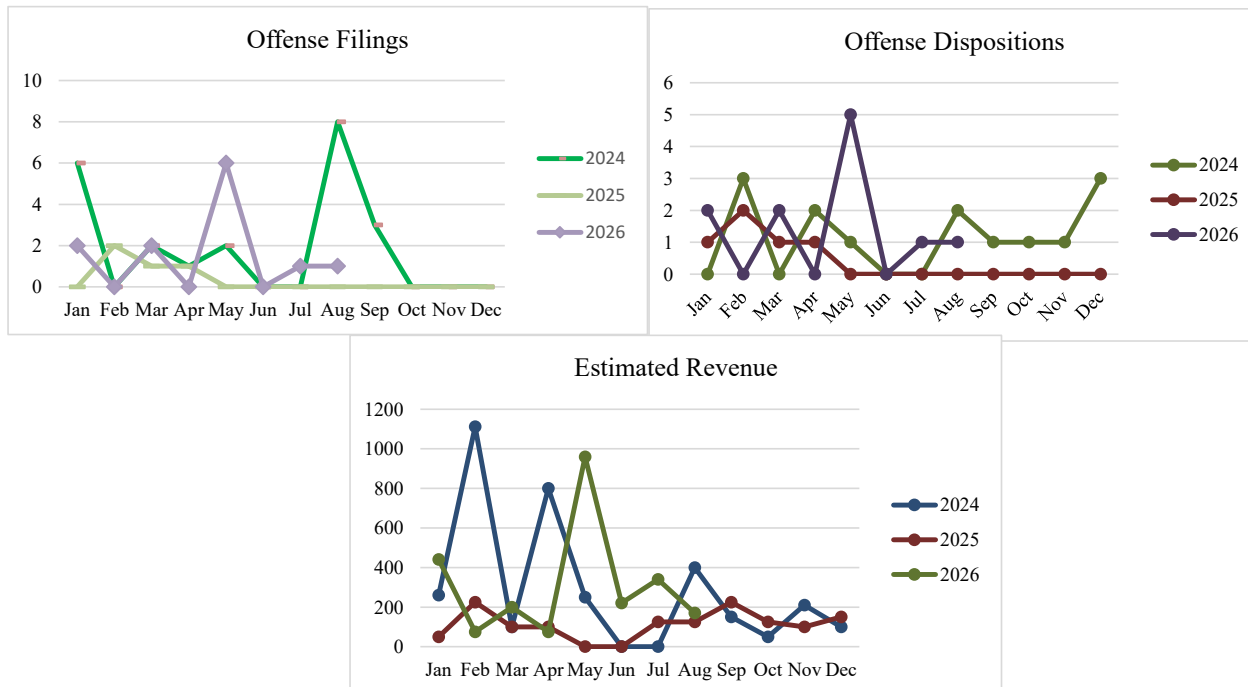

If we do not have anyone showing up, we may pause it completely until summer/school ends. We have also started 2 new groups/programs. Starting in September 14th, we will be having “Chat and Craft, Cards and Cookies” as an adult gathering on Mondays from 1:30pm-3:00pm. We are inviting people to come with their current craft (knitting, crochet, macramé, needlepoint, etc), or just themselves, to gather with others, chat, play group games (or just watch) and just enjoy each others’ company and camaraderie. We are also starting a STEAM group on Mondays “Creators Club” after school from 3:30pm-4:30pm where school age kids can come together to use various building materials/toys and let their imaginations go. Both of these programs should increase door numbers to the library and hopefully act as a service to our town. We will have our SCKLS rotating collection through September but it will be exchanged mid-October for a new set of 300 books.

We are hoping to have enough in our budget at the end of this year to purchase much needed mobile shelving. We could then expand the adult books collection while still being able to host events and functions.

STREETS

In the month of August your city maintenance crew has been working hard to make sure 3rd and Clayhill is patched and ready to be sealed while also addressing other street issues in the process. Hopefully come 2027 we can start sealing up any salvageable streets and milling out any ones beyond help to decrease our liability from road buckling and curb sinking making our town a safer place to travel.

Art Installation for Norman Park

Background/Analysis

RESOLUTION AMENDING FEES CHARGED FOR OPEN RECORDS REQUESTS

Background/Analysis

This is a Resolution to amend the fees charged for Open Records Requests. In continuing to review various fees charged for services, it is recommended that Towanda update the fees charged for Open Records Requests to more accurately reflect the expense incurred in providing such services.

The majority of Open Records Requests require nominal staff time and fall beneath the minimum thresholds that will result in no charge. However, if the City were obligated to respond to more complex or time-consuming records requests, it pulls staff away from regular duties on behalf of Towanda's taxpayers. In these instances, it is appropriate to recoup real and reasonable costs for City resources, including print or electronic copies and staff time.

Financial Impact

To more accurately charge for services based on the costs involved.

Recommended Motion

To adopt Resolution No. 2026-13 to update fees charged for Open Records Requests.

- Electronic Copies: \$0.125 per page equivalent. (No charge for 20 pages or less)
- Retrieval & Inspection of Public Records: Charged at the actual hourly rate of each employee working on the request, increased by 45% to cover fringe benefits.
 - First 30 minutes no charge; overtime rates apply if applicable
 - Staff will provide an estimated time and cost estimate to the requester for any requests anticipated to take more than 30 minutes.
- **All other Fees** are based on real costs incurred in responding to the request, including, but not limited to materials and staff time. Staff time is charged at the rate of pay for each person whose time is used to respond to a request. Additional fees may be assessed to the requester. Time is calculated per quarter hour.

The order shall be served on the owner or agent of such property by certified mail, return receipt requested, or by personal service. If the property is unoccupied and the owner is a nonresident, then by mailing the order by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the last known address of the owner.
- (b) (3.) 10 days from the date of the mailing of the notice to request, as provided in section 8-212 a hearing before the governing body or its designated representative on the matter, and

8-307 Order of Violation

**PETITION FOR ORDINANCE PROHIBITING HIGH IMPACT DATA
CENTERS AND TIER 2 AND TIER 3 BATTERY ENERGY STORAGE
SYSTEMS IN THE CITY OF TOWANDA, KANSAS**

1) High Impact Data Centers present substantial risks to the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Towanda, Kansas, and threaten the stability and capacity of local and regional infrastructure, especially utility infrastructure. Even when closed-loop cooling systems are used, these facilities require significant quantities of water for the initial filling of the cooling loops, ongoing additional water to make up for this water use, and additional routine water system maintenance and chemical treatment. This demand, combined with extreme electrical demand that can overload local and regional power grids, imposes substantial strain on local and regional utilities and competes directly with the essential needs of existing residents and other existing users in the community.

2) Battery Energy Storage Systems ("BESS") present substantial risks and dangers to the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Towanda, Kansas. These risks and dangers include thermal runaway, which is a chain reaction caused by the overheating of battery cells, which can lead to unnatural fires or explosions. Thermal runaway may also release toxic gases, which also pose a serious health hazard to the residents of Towanda, Kansas. The operation of BESS technology could also present hazards of cascading cell service failures and flammable gas accumulation. Multiple incidents have occurred nationally and internationally that clearly demonstrate the risk associated with BESS.

The undersigned electors of the City of Towanda, Kansas, hereby submit this Petition for a proposed ordinance prohibiting High Impact Data Centers and Battery Energy Storage Systems pursuant to K.S.A. § 12-3013 and respectfully request that the governing body of the City of Towanda, Kansas to pass the following ordinance without alteration or submit the same to a vote of the electors.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TOWANDA, KANSAS PROHIBITING THE

WHEREAS, High Impact Data Centers are rapidly evolving land use that has only recently begun to be proposed in jurisdictions across the United States, and the suitability and impact of such facilities on the City of Towanda, Kansas is unstudied and is likely to generate many negative environmental and health impacts, including industrial-scale disruption to existing land uses, current residents, and the environment;

WHEREAS, emerging forms of High Impact Data Center development involve significant electrical and water consumption, causing higher demand leading to additional strain on regional infrastructure that has not been adequately evaluated or addressed;

WHEREAS, High Impact Data Centers generate significant noise and heat, which will also strain municipal services and negatively impact the quality of life of residents of the City of Towanda, Kansas;

WHEREAS, Battery Energy Storage Systems ("BESS") are being deployed with increasing frequency in connection with renewable energy generation facilities, grid stability projects, and commercial and industrial applications; and

WHEREAS, documented BESS accidents have resulted in explosions, prolonged fires, toxic gas emissions, and injuries to emergency response personnel.

WHEREAS, Tier 2 and Tier 3 BESS present significant fire, explosion, and thermal runaway risks that endanger the City of Towanda, Kansas, particularly first responders, properties near BESS, and other residents of the City of Towanda, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOWANDA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Ordinance is to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Towanda, Kansas, by prohibiting the installation and operation of High Impact Data Centers and Tier 2 and Tier 3 Battery Energy Storage Systems ("BESS").

SECTION 2. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

- A. "High Impact Data Center" means a principal use consisting of one or more buildings, structures, or facilities whose primary purpose is the housing, operation, and maintenance of computer servers, data storage devices, networking equipment, and associated infrastructure (including but not limited to cooling systems, backup power generators, substations, and high-capacity electrical and water systems) for the bulk processing, storage, or transmission of electronic data, that requires a peak electrical load exceeding ten (10) megawatts, or a daily water draw exceeding one hundred thousand (100,000) gallons. This term includes server farms, colocation facilities, AI training facilities, cryptocurrency mining operations, and similar high-density computing facilities, provided however, that High Impact Data Center does not include accessory data processing equipment that is incidental and subordinate to the

primary use of a building (e.g., ordinary office servers, school computer labs, or manufacturing process controls).

- B. "Battery Energy Storage System" or "BESS" means: An engineered facility (inclusive of all ancillary facilities required to interconnect and operate the facility) that is capable of charging batteries from an electrical transmission system, storing the electrical energy, and discharging the electrical energy to later reenergize the same system and does not include a power plant or other manner of generating electricity for distribution and storage. BESS may also include one or more devices, when assembled together, are capable of storing energy to supply electrical energy at a future time, provided however, that BESS does not include a stand-alone twelve-volt car battery or an electric motor vehicle. A battery energy storage system is classified as a Tier 1, Tier 2, or Tier 3 battery energy storage system as follows:

- (i) Tier 1 battery energy storage systems have an aggregate energy capacity less than or equal to 80 kWh and, if in a room or enclosed area, consist of only a single energy storage system technology. All Tier 1 battery energy storage systems located on residential properties shall comply with all applicable codes (building, fire, property, etc.) as they may currently be in effect or hereafter amended in the City of Towanda.
- (ii) Tier 2 battery energy storage systems have an aggregate energy capacity between 81 and 600 kWh or are comprised of more than one energy storage system technology in a room or enclosed area.
- (iii) Tier 3 battery energy storage systems have an aggregate energy capacity greater than 600 kWh and, if in a room or enclosed area, consist of only one energy storage system technology. An engineered facility (means one or more devices, assembled together, capable of storing energy in order to supply electrical energy at a future time, not to include a stand-alone 12-volt car battery or an electric motor vehicle. A BESS includes all equipment required for the system to operate, including but not limited to batteries, battery chargers, battery management systems, controls, power conditioning systems, inverters, associated electrical equipment, fire suppression systems, and thermal management systems.

SECTION 3. No person, firm, corporation, or other entity shall construct, install, operate, maintain, or cause to be constructed, installed, operated, or maintained, any High Impact Data Center in the jurisdictional boundaries City of Towanda, Kansas.

SECTION 4. No person, firm, corporation, or other entity shall construct, install, operate, maintain, or cause to be constructed, installed, operated, or maintained, any Tier 2 or Tier 3 BESS in the jurisdictional boundaries City of Towanda, Kansas.

SECTION 5. Multiple Tier 1 BESS shall not be installed or operated in a configuration or proximity that would function to effectively create a Tier 2 or Tier 3 BESS. The following factors shall be considered in determining whether multiple Tier 1 BESS constitute an effective Tier 2 or Tier 3 BESS:

- (i) Whether the total aggregate capacity exceeds the thresholds defined in Section 2;
- (ii) Whether systems that are located within 50 feet of each other on the same parcel or on adjacent parcels under common ownership or control;

- (iii) Whether systems share electrical components, fire suppression systems, or control systems;
- (iv) Whether systems are designed to function as an integrated unit; or
- (v) Whether systems are managed through a common energy management system or controller.

SECTION 6. The prohibition set forth in this Ordinance shall apply to all zoning districts and all land uses within the City of Towanda, Kansas, including but not limited to, residential, commercial, industrial, institutional, and public facility zones as defined in the applicable zoning ordinances and resolutions, as currently in effect and as may hereafter be amended from time to time.

SECTION 7. Any violation of Section 3 or Section 4 of this Ordinance shall be subject to the civil and criminal penalties as set forth in Article 15 of the City of Towanda Zoning Regulations.

SECTION 8. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof. Similarly, if any exemption, variance, or procedural provision is found invalid, it is the express intent that the core prohibitions shall remain in effect to the maximum extent permitted by law.

SECTION 9. Where the requirements of this Ordinance impose a different restriction or requirement than imposed by other City of Towanda Ordinances, or other applicable rules or regulations, the requirements of this Ordinance shall prevail.

SECTION 10. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force either upon publication as described by K.S.A. § 12-3007, or upon approval by the electors pursuant to K.S.A. § 12-3013, as applicable.
